STUDENT EXCHANGE PROGRAMME WITH SCIENCES PO, RENNES, FRANCE

UNYT announces that it is accepting applications from students interested to pursue a student exchange semester-long (**Fall 2017**) or a year-long study at the Institute of Political Science in Rennes, France. While priority shall be given to Political Science / International Relations, Law, Economics and Management student applicants, applications by other motivated students shall also be considered. **Dead-Line for Applications:** April 17, 2017. **Selection Criteria:** **1. G.P.A.:** 80%. **2. Motivation Letter:** 20%. Up to 10% bonus points could be awarded for certified knowledge of French depending on the level and current engagement of students in French language learning.

The Institute of Political Science in Rennes, France is one of the nine *Grandes Écoles* for Political Science in France. Their attraction lies in the specific training and approach it provides. The Institute is highly selective, with strict admissions criteria, a multidisciplinary approach, a distinct international orientation and a multi-ethnic and multi-cultural student population.
