



CALL FOR APPLICATIONS FOR INTERNATIONAL CREDIT MOBILITY

Student Exchange Program with the Middle East Technical University, Ankara, Turkey

UNYT is accepting applications from undergraduate¹, graduate and doctoral students interested in the **Spring 2017-18** semester-long student credit mobility exchange at the Middle East Technical University (METU), Ankara, Turkey. The selection procedure will involve two application assessments, one at UNYT and another one at METU. The UNYT Selection Committee will nominate up to five (5) students for exchange on the basis of grade GPA average (60%) and quality of application folder (40%). The Committee strictly adheres to the principles of non-discrimination, equal access and opportunities to mobile participants from all backgrounds, in particular disadvantaged or vulnerable groups. Successful applicants will attend a number of courses at METU to be integrated into their UNYT degree programs, in consultation with their advisors.

Master`s/PhD Students: METU will accept graduate students for exchange **only if:**

They either agree to take courses at METU, or they find a Research Supervisor at METU (by themselves) who is ready to accept to study with the student. In this case, the student should submit an **acceptance letter** from the agreed supervisor during the application period. Please note that it is not possible for International Cooperation's Office to assign academic supervisors to students who want to conduct research work at METU.

Dead-Line for Applications & Application Items: November 01, 2017, 17.00, Albanian time (GMT+2). **1)** Letter of Motivation. **2)** CV. **3)** Transcript of Records. **4)** Proof of English Language **5)** Copy of passport. Tuition Fees & Financial Support: Successful candidates will be charged UNYT's tuition fees for the equivalent number of credits and no tuition fees are to be paid to the host institution. **Erasmus+ International Credit Mobility (ICM)** program is supported by a funding mechanism provided by the EU Commission. Outgoing students from Albania to Turkey receive an allowance of 800 € per month and travel support amounting to 275 € (one-time).
