



CALL FOR APPLICATIONS FOR TEACHING STAFF MOBILITY

Exchange Programme with the Middle East Technical University, Ankara, Turkey

Dear Colleagues,

We are now accepting applications for academic staff teaching mobility (5 to 30 working days) at the Middle East Technical University (METU), Ankara, Turkey. The selection procedure will involve two application assessments, one at UNYT and another one at METU. The UNYT Selection Committee will nominate up to two (2) staff members for exchange on the basis of quality of the mobility proposal (60%) and documented potential for spin-off collaboration after the mobility (40%). The Committee strictly adheres to the principles of non-discrimination, equal access and opportunities to mobile participants from all backgrounds, in particular disadvantaged or vulnerable groups. Successful applicants will be expected to engage in teaching activity (no training activity is available at this time's call) in various forms, such as seminars, lectures, tutorials, etc. Please note that the **minimum number of teaching hours per week is 8**. Minimum number of teaching hours for an incomplete week, if the mobility lasts longer than one week, should be proportional to the duration of that week.

Financial Support: Erasmus+ International Credit Mobility (ICM) programme is supported by a generous funding mechanism provided by the EU Commission.
