



CALL FOR APPLICATIONS

STUDENT EXCHANGE PROGRAMME WITH SCIENCES PO, RENNES, FRANCE (Spring 2019)

UNYT announces that it is accepting applications from students interested to pursue a student exchange semester-long (**Spring 2019, January-May**) study at the Institute of Political Science in Rennes, France. Priority shall be given to Political Science / International Relations, while other (Law, Economics and Management) student applicants shall also be considered.

Up to three students can be accepted for this semester under the framework of International Credit Mobility, Erasmus + Program.

For 144 days each, from January 7th, 2019 to May 31st 2019, each student could receive 850 EUR per month plus 275 EUR as a contribution for travel.

<u>Dead-Line for Applications</u>: October 30, 2018, 17.00, Albanian time <u>Selection Criteria & their Weight</u>: 1. G.P.A: 60% (no lower than 3.00). 2. Quality of application folder (40%). A second round of selection will be pursued by Science Po.

The Institute of Political Science in Rennes, France is one of the nine *Grandes Écoles* for Political Science in France. Their attraction lies in the specific training and approach it provides. The Institute is highly selective, with strict admissions criteria, a multidisciplinary approach, a distinct international orientation and a multi-ethnic and multi-cultural student population. Successful applicants will attend a number of courses (in English or French) to be integrated into their UNYT curriculum, in consultations with their supervisors; they will pay UNYT's tuition fees for the equivalent number of credits.
