Successful applicants will attend a number of courses (in Spanish or English) to be integrated into their UNYT curriculum, in consultations with their supervisors; they will pay UNYT's tuition fees for the equivalent number of credits.

<u>Application Items for Master Students:</u> 1) ID/PASSPORT. 2) Official Language Proficiency Certificate. (Spanish and English) 3) Official proof of registration in the Master Programme at the home university. 4) Pre-admission letter signed by the UGR coordinator/tutor of the Master Programme.
