Selection Criteria & their Weight: **1.** G.P.A: 60% (no lower than 3.0). **2.** Quality of application folder (40%). **3.** The applicant must have 30+ credits in their official transcript! A second round of selection will be pursued by University of Granada.

Successful applicants will attend a number of courses (in Spanish or English) to be integrated into their UNYT curriculum, in consultations with their supervisors; they will pay UNYT's tuition fees for the equivalent number of credits.

(Spanish and English) **3)** Course selection at UGR and UNYT conversion signed and approved by advisor **4)** Official transcript of records signed and stamped by the home university.

Application Items for Master Students: **1)** ID/PASSPORT. **2)** Official Language Proficiency Certificate. (Spanish and English) **3)** Official proof of registration in the Master Programme at the home university. **4)** Pre-admission letter signed by the UGR coordinator/tutor of the Master Programme.
