General Selection Criteria & their Weight:

1. G.P.A no lower than 2.5;
2. **Students studying at the Department of Business Administration, Department of Economics and Finance, Department of Business and E-Business, Department of Computer Science, and Department of Information and Intelligent Systems** are welcome to apply;
3. The student must have conducted at least 1 (one) year of full study/ 32 or more ECTS;
4. Students are required to demonstrate a minimum level (B1) of English Language

***Please note that:**

- A second round of selection will be pursued by Siauliai State College of Applied Sciences.
- Successful applicants will attend a number of courses (in English) to be integrated into their UNYT curriculum, in consultations with their supervisors and they will pay UNYT's tuition fees for the equivalent number of credits.
